

Home Health Care System Features and Functions

Desktop

Collect and maintain:

Electronic Transfer

Schedule information and required data is electronically transferred from the desktop to the handheld. During the home visit the Health Care Provider has the ability to select any of the available forms from the Home Health Care Menu. Any data previously entered on the desktop will be pre-populated on the handheld eliminating redundancy of effort.

Handheld

The handheld uses radio buttons, check boxes, and drop-down technology. Each question is validated using the CMS OASIS-B1 guidelines ensuring accurate data collection during the Home Health Care visit. Status checks will be displayed at the end of each OASIS section to indicate the accuracy of the collected patient information thereby allowing the health care provider the opportunity to correct the information before leaving the patient.
